



Syllabus Adding Detail to Balloon Figures

Class Objective: To teach students various methods of adding detail to non-round balloon figures.

Completion of Class: Students will be able to add details such as saddles, bridles, lariats, unique hairdos, hats, helmets, goggles and sports equipment to one balloon, multiple balloons, and combined balloon made with non-round balloons.

Class Level: Intermediate to advanced

Class Format: Lecture, Demonstration, and Hands-on

Materials Needed: Pencil or Pen and Paper if you plan to take notes, scissors, and a hand pump or other inflation device to inflate balloons unless you are able to inflate by mouth. Balloons will be provided by Pioneer Balloon Company.
