Avoiding Problems with Christmas party entertainment

One problem I have seen over my many years of balloon entertaining is overwhelming the Christmas party entertainer with children. When planning a Christmas party it is vital to have an exact number count of kids attending. Most organizers assume

Santa will be the main focus of the children, but this is a misconception. Many times the balloon line exceeds Santa's line. To prevent this problem, estimate 1.5 minutes per child. Thirty to thirty-five kids an hour, one hundred kids consider two hours minimal.

If time constraint is a problem, consider hiring multiple entertainers. People do not like

waiting in long lines; line length should only be 10-15 people for a corporate Christmas party.
